- 1. Read all of the assignments, read them carefully, and read them critically. The average amount of reading per class is about 68 pages. In a seminar, the contribution that each person makes to the discussions is important.
- 2. Attend all the classes and participate in the discussions. Participation will count towards 10% of your grade.
- 3. A term paper, 4500 6000 words (15 20 pages) in length, on a topic of your choosing (although I'm happy to help you choose), written in two drafts and worth 60% of your grade. You must submit a paper proposal, 300 words (1 page) in length, at the beginning of class on March 5. You must submit a rough draft, 3000 words (10 pages) in length, at the beginning of class on April 2. And the final draft is due at the beginning of class on May 7.
- 4. Two in-class presentations, 1200 1500 words (4 5 pages) in length, each worth 15% of your grade. 15 copies should be made and distributed in class. People who are presenting on the same day should meet beforehand to avoid redundancy in the presentations.
